DEDICATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we the undersigned, owners of the following described property, being a portion of the "Leap Year Placer", Mineral Survey No. 13358 in Foliole Mining District, Summit County, Colorado, lying in portions of Sections 18 and 19, Township 7 South, Range 71 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a stone identified as Corner No. 2, Leap Year Placer; thence South 71°30' East, 477.10 feet to the true point of beginning, which point lies 75.00 feet East of Centerline Station 222+33 of the proposed alignment of State Highway No. 9 and on the East right-of-way of said Highway No. 9; thence South 14°58' East along said East right-of-way line 781.60 feet; thence 897.82 feet to the left along the arc of a 2826.60 foot radius curve, said arc subtending a central angle of 22°51'; thence South 7°53' East, 36.30 feet; thence 650.67 feet to the right along the arc of a 2789.61 foot radius curve, said arc subtending a central angle of 13°22'; thence South 5°29' West, 49.35 feet to a point; all above points lie on the East right-of-way of the proposed alignment of State Highway No. 9; thence South 87°23' East; 687.04 feet to the East line of the Leap Year Placer; thence North 2°31' East, 2400 feet more or less along said East line to Corner No. 8, Leap Year Placer; thence North 87°31' East, 400.00 feet along the South line of said Placer; thence North 2°29' West, 618.20 feet; thence South 87°31' West, 201.70 feet; thence South 80°47' West, 195.71 feet; thence South 66°34' West, 331.00 feet; thence South 68°50' West, 184.40 feet more or less to the point of beginning, containing 49.660 acres more or less, have laid out, subdivided and platted the same into lots under the name and style of BLUE RIVER ESTATES, INC, BLUE ROCK SPRINGS SUBDN, as shown hereon and do by these presents grant and convey to the owners of the lots thereon the uses of all river easements and road easements as shown thereon.

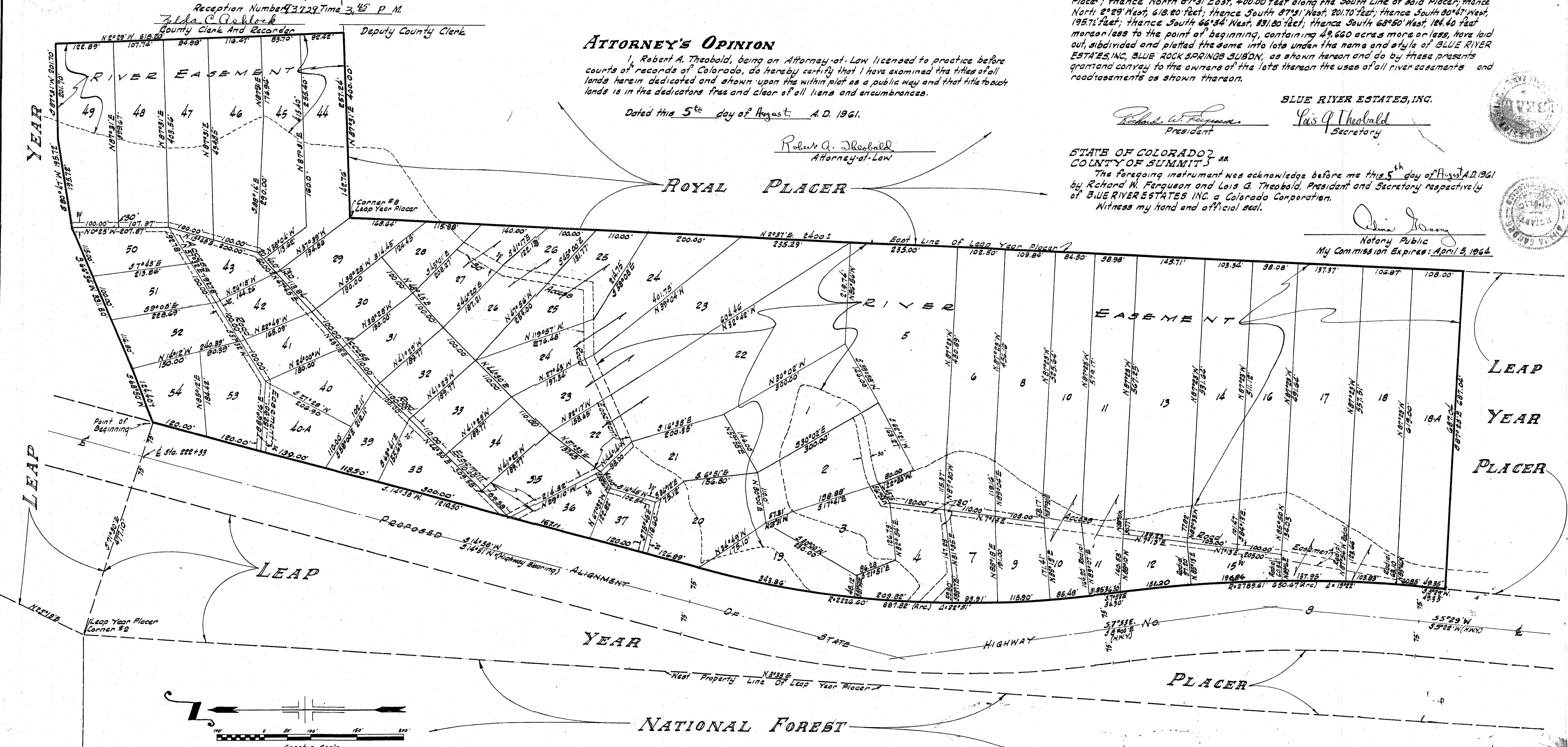
