I. Noxious Weed Management Advisory Board

- The group reviewed of Nederland Plan and suggestions by Tori Aidala
 - Tori provided a markup of Nederland's Weed Management Plan.
 - It was noted that Michelle will take the notes and draft the plan for July.
 - Notes to keep A, B, C list and definitions.
 - Create a table that will be list specific for Blue River in addition to what is listed as they are all pertinent. The Blue River ones would be the REQUIRED under list A.
 - Under Public Education include the committee as the spirit of cooperation.
 - Include concept of revegetation of native plants as a requirement.
 - Recommend that if did own inventory it would be based on information received and include on a GIS map to identify target area. This would be created over time with resident submittals.
 - Suggestion to have an online form with information and include Summit County weed program for resident submittal. Recommended to have a priority along the roadways and the town park.
 - Note to use what the town has listed as seed mixes as well as what Summit County has listed. Possibly include USFS.
 - Add information on the county spraying program. Provide alternatives to chemical treatment.
 - Suggestion to research compost information with HC3 and include their rules/regulations.
 - Code enforcement will be in the way of education. Identification of issues will come via complaint driven with photos. Education would be information on removal and revegetation.

- Under resources include USFS; Eagle; Middle Park; White River Nation Forest; Colorado Native Plants. Martie will provide a complete list.
- The add list are in the b or c list. Tori will help review once table is established.
- Suggestion to include pictures of the native plants.
