Bear Resistant Trash Can

Each home is eligible for one grant of **\$150** for purchase of a bear resistant trash can. Please attach a photo of the purchased receptacle and a copy of your receipt of purchase. Trash cans must be stored next to the home, in a shed or garage and may not be left curbside except for trash collection day.

Wildfire Grant Program

Grants will be awarded on a sliding scale depending on project, cost and impact up to \$1,000.

Eligible Projects *Grant award does not include permitting nor fees*

- Defensible building materials “hardening” of the home.
 - Drip line around the entire structure.
 - Firewise landscaping within 30’.
 - Minimum of 6” of noncombustible siding where the home hits the ground or any other horizontal surface like decks or walkways.
 - Zone 1 and/or 2 defensible space.

Natural Night Sky Lighting

Grants are for any new projects to encourage adaptation of lighting to night sky friendly lighting.
